Grants

Accelerated Degree Program Grant

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a junior or senior.
- be taking classes in the summer.
- enter the Accelerated Degree Program.
- complete a FAFSA for the current academic year.
- use federal funds (Title IV student loans and Pell Grants) for tuition and fees.
- be continuously enrolled, including the summer semester.
- register for at least 8 semester hours in both the fall and spring.
- register for only 8 semester hours in the summer.

Award: Up to \$2,500 toward unfunded tuition and fees. May be renewable with reapplication. Cannot be combined with any other Amridge grant or scholarship

Corporate Alliance Award

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- work for a company with at least two employees enrolled.
- be enrolled at least half time.
- Provide a letter of employment from the company Human Resources Department.

Award: Special per-hour tuition rate of:

- \$285 for undergraduate students.
- \$445 for graduate students.
- \$560 for eligible doctor of ministry students.
- \$655 for eligible doctor of philosophy students.

Not available for Turner School of Theology graduate or doctoral degrees.

Home School Student Award

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a home-school graduate.
- have no previous college experience.
- be enrolled at least half time.
- maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- not fail any course.
- not drop a course during the semester.
- not withdraw from the university during the semester.

Award: Special per-hour tuition rate of \$250 for full-time students and \$330 for part-time students. Students in good academic standing who maintain continuous enrollment are guaranteed these rates through graduation.

Law Enforcement and First Responders Tuition Award

Eligibility: Must provide documentation of current employment as a police officer, sheriff, deputy, firefighter, EMT or corrections officer.

Award: Special per-hour tuition rate of:

- \$250 for undergraduate students.
- \$350 for graduate students.
- \$450 for doctoral students

Professional Credentialing Award

Eligibility: Must not be enrolled in a degree program.

Award: Waiver of the \$1,200 course fee. Any other fees associated with the course will be charged.

Sister Institution Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a current full-time faculty or staff member who has been employed for at least one year at a Church of Christ-affiliated university, college or academy or be the spouse or dependent of a full-time faculty or staff member.
- provide a letter annually from the academic dean of the university or college or the headmaster of the academy verifying full-time employment and length of employment.
- provide proof of marriage for a spouse or proof of relationship for a dependent.
- be enrolled at least half time.

Award: Special per-hour tuition rate of \$235 for undergraduate students and \$395 for graduate students for first non-doctoral degree.

Dr. Rex and Barbara Turner Ministerial Scholarship

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- be a current paid pulpit or youth minister for a Church of Christ.
- be enrolled at least half time.
- provide a statement of faith.
- provide a letter of employment from the elders of the church paying the salary.

Award: Special per-hour tuition rate of:

- \$335 for eligible bachelor's degrees.
- \$560 for eligible master's degrees.
- \$600 for eligible doctor of ministry degrees.
- \$675 for eligible doctor of philosophy degrees.

Undergraduate First-time Freshman Award

Eligibility: The applicant must:

- have no previous college experience.
- be enrolled at least half time.
- maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- not fail any course.
- be continuously enrolled in the fall and spring semesters.
- not drop a course during the semester.
- not withdraw from the university during the semester.

Award: \$250 per semester hour for full-time students, \$330 per semester hour for part-time students. Students in good academic standing who maintain continuous enrollment are guaranteed these rates through graduation.

Academic Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be an incoming freshman.

Award: Based on weighted cumulative high school GPA and ACT or SAT test score:

- Up to a 3.4 GPA and up to a 20 ACT or 1030 SAT: \$3,000 to \$6,000
- Up to a 3.4 GPA and a 21–23 ACT or 1060–1150 SAT: \$5,000 to \$7,000
- Up to a 3.4 GPA and a 24–36 ACT or 1160–1600 SAT: \$6,000 to \$8,000
- 3.4 or higher GPA and up to a 23 ACT or 1150 SAT: \$6,000 to \$9,000
- 3.4 or higher GPA and a 24–30 ACT or 1160–1380 SAT: \$7,000 to \$10,000

- 3.4 or higher GPA and a 21–36 ACT or 1390–1600 SAT: \$8,000 to \$11,000

Academic Test Optional Scholarship

Award: Based on weighted cumulative high school GPA:

- Up to a 3.0 GPA: \$5,000 to \$6,000
- 3.0–3.5 GPA: \$5,000 to \$7,000
- 3.5–3.8 GPA: \$6,000 to \$9,000
- 3.8–4.1 GPA: \$7,000 to \$11,000
- 4.1 or higher GPA: \$9,000 to \$11,000

National Merit Scholarship

Eligibility: Must be an incoming freshman and be a National Merit Scholar or have been recognized by the National African American, Hispanic, Indigenous, or Rural and Small Town Recognition program.

Award: \$2,000 in addition to an Academic Scholarship; renewable

Fine and Performing Arts Scholarships

Eligibility: Must complete an audition with Fine and Performing Arts faculty, preferably during a scholarship program.

Deadline: Must apply for admission by February 1

Architecture Studies Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on a portfolio, writing sample and interview.

Portfolio pieces must be from life, not from photographs. The portfolio should include:

- a still drawing.
- a one-point perspective drawing.
- a two-point perspective drawing.
- an elevation rendering of one of the following: the applicant's house or school or a single building in their town.

In addition to the portfolio requirements, the applicant should include sketchbooks and/or examples of work done in disciplines other than drawing, such as paintings that fit within the 30-inch maximum size, photographs, prints, or mixed-media work.

Art Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on a digital portfolio. The portfolio should include a:

- portrait or self-portrait in graphite from life, not from a photograph.
- still life drawing in line.
- still life drawing in value.
- still life in color.
- hand or foot from life, not from a photograph.
- perspective from life, not from a photograph
- short written artist statement.

An applicant may also include examples of work done in other disciplines, such as painting, photographs, prints, and mixed media.

Art History Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on writing sample and interview. The writing sample should be a one- to two-page visual analysis of artwork of the student's choosing and should include a scanned or photocopied reproduction of the artwork analyzed.

Media and Film Studies Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on a digital portfolio. The applicant should:

- submit a film/media sample (i.e., film, podcast, webisode, photography, radio broadcast, documentary, video essay, digital art, music video, virtual reality) or a creative short story/screenplay writing sample.
- submit a written statement on one of these prompts: "What is a major project you would like to achieve, and who would you do it with?" or "What would you do with a completely free day?"
- attend an interview.

Music Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on an audition video. Singers are expected to sing at least two songs from memory in contrasting style. Pianists are expected to play from memory two pieces of at least the difficulty of the Bach Inventions or the sonatas of Haydn or Mozart.

Organists are expected to play one of the easier Bach preludes and fugues or works of comparable difficulty.

Instrumentalists or guitarists should play two pieces or etudes in contrasting styles.

Composers should send two or more original compositions and recordings (if available).

Musical Theatre Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on audition tapes. The applicant must:

- prepare 16 measures each from two Broadway or off-Broadway songs.
- provide one monologue of no longer than one minute. The material should be close to their age and experience (no Shakespeare or dialects).
- submit an 8-x-10 head shot.
- submit a résumé.

Theatre Scholarship

Eligibility: Based on an audition video. The applicant should:

- submit two monologues of no longer than 1 minute each. The material should be close to their age and experience (no Shakespeare or dialects).
- submit an 8-x-10 head shot.
- submit a résumé.
